Student Record Cards

We have spent the last 6 months designing Student Record Cards for both the juniors and the seniors, the senior cards have been tested out over the past 2 months on 3 students, to see how they could be used to benefit both the student and the instructor. The trial has been very successful and we will therefore be using these cards for all students in the future.

Along with this newsletter you will have received a Student Record Card for the belt that you will be working towards over the next 3 months. **PLEASE** look after this card and bring it with you to every training session.

On page 1 of the card is a list of all the moves that you need to learn and a record of how well you are doing at each move. There are 4 columns in which a date will be placed by your sensei to let you know which standard you have achieved and what you need to be aiming for.

On page 2 is a record of the number of training sessions you have attended. This will show you if you have attended the correct number of training sessions required before your grading.

When you arrive for a training session, please hand your Student Record Card into Amanda, who will mark the date of attendance on Page 2.

All the Student Record Cards will then be put onto a clip board and given to Sensei Rob to work from. Sensei Rob will now know at a glance what each student is working on and will mark their progress as it happens through the session.

If you are a junior then don't forget to COLLECT your card from one of the junior leaders at the end of your training session. If you are a senior then see Sensei Rob or Amanda for your card.

We will be providing these cards FREE of charge after each grade, but due to the expense of printing them we will have to charge £2.00 for replacing any lost or damaged cards, it is your responsibility to look after your Student Record Card.

As we approach the next grading on 13th December 2007, each student should be able to tell from their record card if they are ready for the grading, and if they are not then they and Sensei Rob will know what they need to work on to enable them to make the grade.

These cards will be a huge benefit to both you and your coach as you will both be able to monitor your progress to your next belt, but we do need your help to get the best use out of them by looking after them and remembering to bring them along to training!
